Activity Details

"Getting To Know You"

Take a short walk around downtown Berkeley and move on to the Gourmet Ghetto in North Berkeley. North Berkeley is home of the famous Chez Panisse Restaurant and many other specialty stores. The relaxed atmosphere provides an opportunity to chat with local contemporaries. We'll stop along the way to have a light lunch or snacks. (lunch/snacks extra)



Muir Woods and Stinson Beach

Travel across the Golden Gate Bridge to Muir Woods where we pass through groves of giant Sequoia trees and walk around the small town of Stinson Beach. (lunch extra)

Golden Gate Park & The Palace of the Legion of Honor or The De Young Museum

Cross the Oakland Bay bridge, through San Francisco for a leisurely drive through Golden Gate Park and on to the Palace of the Legion of Honor or the De Young museum where we visit the exhibitions. (entrance fees extra)



Union Square, Maiden Alley & Chinatown

We make our way to the heart of downtown San Francisco, where we walk through Union Square, then down Maiden Lane for a snack and on to Grant Avenue and Chinatown. (lunch extra)

University of California, Berkeley Campus

Walk to the university and have a light lunch on campus. Tour the main part of the campus and take the elevator up to the top of the Campanile for a beautiful view of the San Francisco Bay. (lunch extra)
