



INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PATHWAY FACT SHEET 2010

Accreditation:

Language Studies International New York is accredited by the **New York State Education Department and ACCET**. It is a member of the **New York English Schools Association**.

Metropolitan College of New York is accredited by the **Board of Regents of the University of the State of New York and the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools**. The College is approved for the training of veterans and other eligible persons by the New York State Education Department.

Starting Dates:

LSI New York's general program has a weekly enrollment system. Academic Preparation courses are typically 3, 6 or 9 months long.

MCNY runs three semesters each year:

- January 7, 2010
- May 3, 2010
- September 7, 2010

Undergraduate Admissions:

Students interested in undergraduate programs must provide proof of graduation from a secondary school or its equivalent and proof of English proficiency. All foreign academic credentials must be evaluated.

Graduate Admissions:

Students interested in graduate programs must provide proof of graduation from a recognized Bachelor Degree granting institution and proof of English proficiency. GMAT is recommended for all MBA candidates. All foreign academic credentials must be evaluated.

English Proficiency:

TOEFL requirement is waived for students who achieve the Proficiency level (106) at LSI.

Undergraduate students who achieve the Proficiency level (106) at LSI may take up to 6 credits on a part-time basis while enrolled full-time at LSI New York.

Transfer Policy:

Undergraduate transfer students may transfer course credits in which a grade of "C" or better was awarded. Students with foreign academic

credentials **must** provide a course-by-course evaluation conducted by one of the following services:

- World Education Services (www.wes.org)
- Globe Language Services, Inc. (www.globelanguage.com)
- ECE (www.ece.org)

English Test Scores:

- **LSI Advanced Certificate**
- **TOEFL (Undergraduate)** – scores of 61 IBT, 155 CBT or 500 PBT
- **TOEFL (Graduate)** – scores of 80 IBT, 213 CBT, or 550 PBT
- **IELTS (Undergraduate)** – score of 5.0 or better
- **IELTS (Graduate)** – scores of 5.5 or better

PROGRAMS OF STUDY

Associate's Degrees –

- Human Services
- Business Administration

Students who attend continuously may finish their Associate Degree in 18 months.

Bachelor's Degrees –

- Human Services
- Business Administration
- Liberal Arts: American Urban Studies

Students who attend continuously may finish their Bachelor Degree in 2 years and 8 months.

Master's Degrees –

- MBA – General Management
- MBA – Media Management
- MBA – Financial Services
- MPA – Public Affairs and Administration
- MPA - Emergency and Disaster Management
- MSED – Childhood Education (1-6)

Students may finish some graduate programs in 1 year and others in 16 months.

CPT:

MCNY's philosophy of Purpose Centered Education means you learn by doing. Here, employment is a component of the educational experience; therefore, our program allows students to work part-time while pursuing their full-time studies.

MCNY has the authority to grant students curriculum practicum training* (CPT) beginning in their 2nd semester (a 5-month attendance requirement applies) during their time of study.

The College's Career Service Office assist students in arranging internship, CPT and OPT** opportunities, through the educational relationships the College has developed with employers.

* Students may work full-time (once recommended by MCNY) during summer semesters

** Students may work full time (once approved by USCIS) for a period of 12 months upon graduating from a degree program (OPT)

APPLICATION CHECKLIST

For Undergraduate Candidates:

- A completed MCNY admissions application
- A \$30 (US Dollars) application fee
- Official high school or secondary transcript of academic grades and proof of graduation
- Proof of English proficiency – TOEFL scores or LSI Advanced Certificate of Completion)
- Official bank statement providing proof of the availability of \$28,200 (US Dollars) in liquid funds
- Vaccination records showing proof of MMR immunization
- Depending on academic background, an entrance exam may be required

For Graduate Candidates:

- A completed MCNY admissions application
- An essay of 300-500 words (see below)
- A \$45 (US Dollars) application fee
- An earned Bachelor's Degree from an accredited institution
- Official transcripts form all previously attended colleges and universities (foreign credentials must be evaluated)
- 2 letters of recommendation
- GMAT scores are recommended (**MBA candidates only**)
- Vaccination records showing proof of MMR immunization
- Official bank statement providing proof of the availability of liquid funds in US Dollars to cover expenses for 1 academic year (please contact Patricia Ramos, Assistant Director of Admissions by

emailing pramos@mcny.edu for an accurate amount for each individual program)
