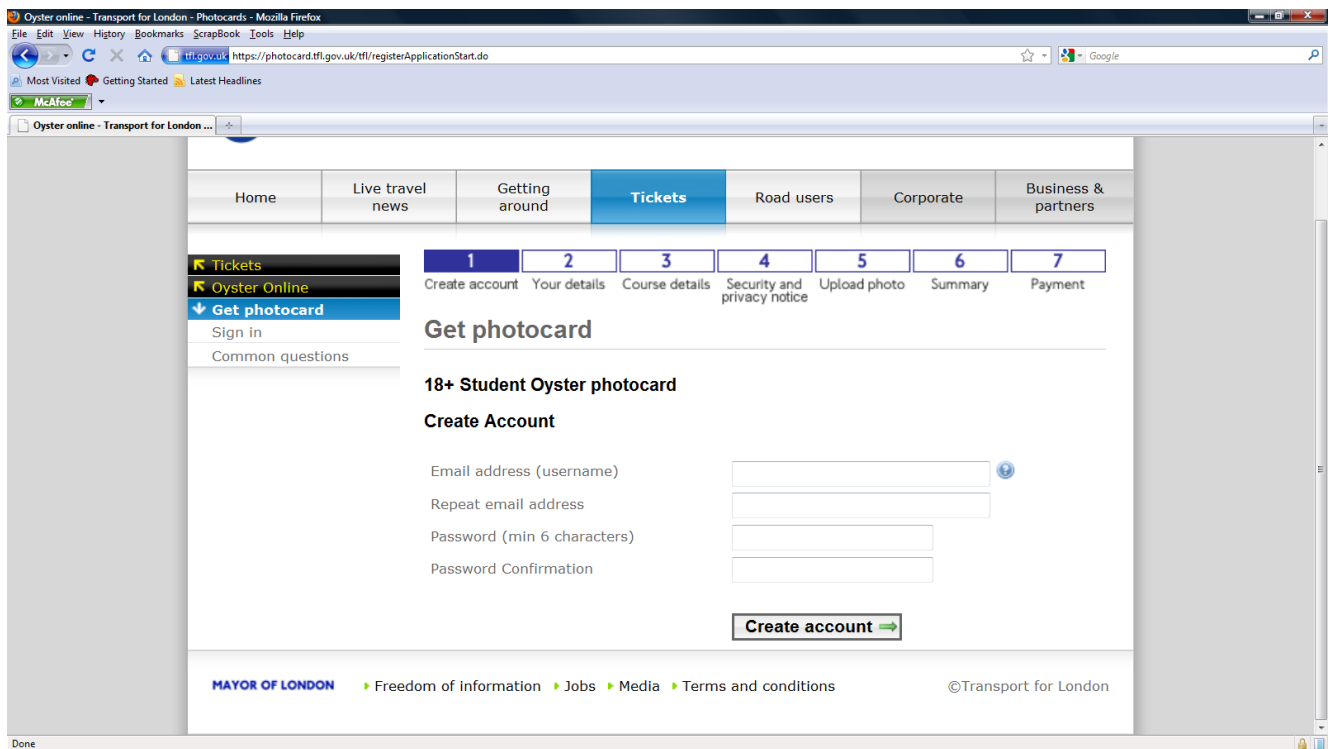


If you are studying at LSI for 14 weeks or more, follow the instructions below to get your Student Oyster card. This will allow you to get cheaper travel when you are in London.

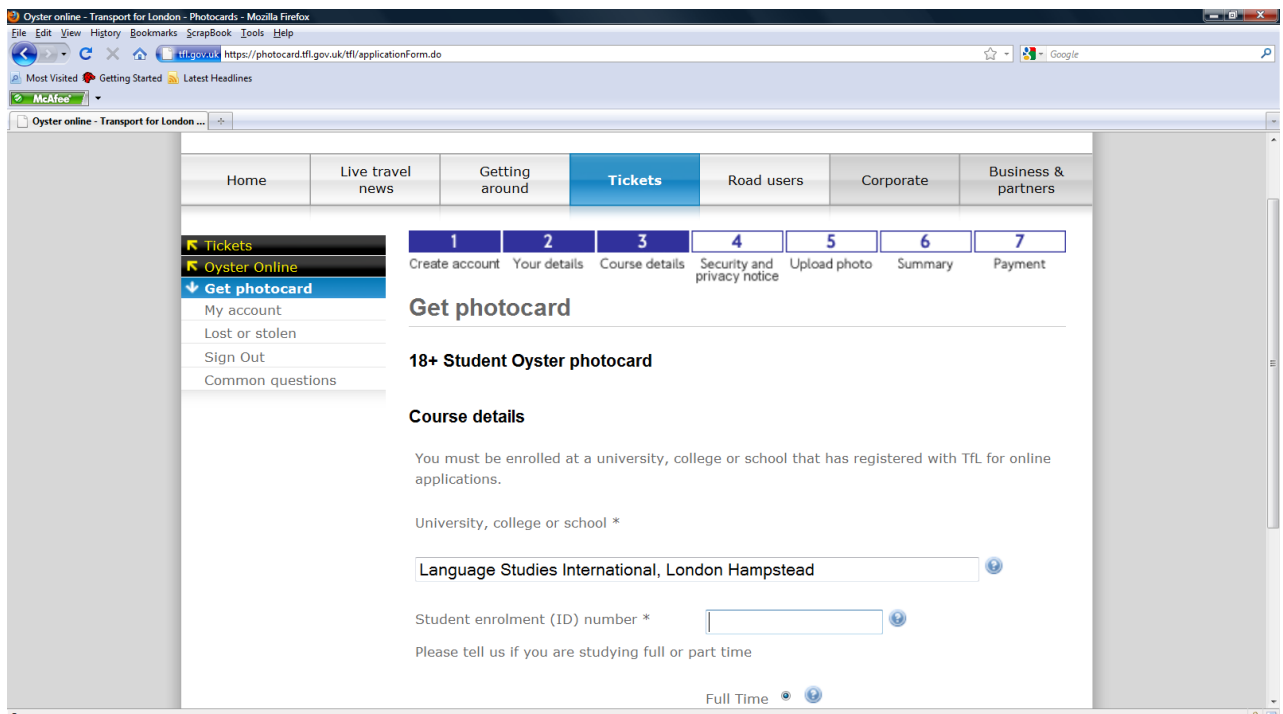
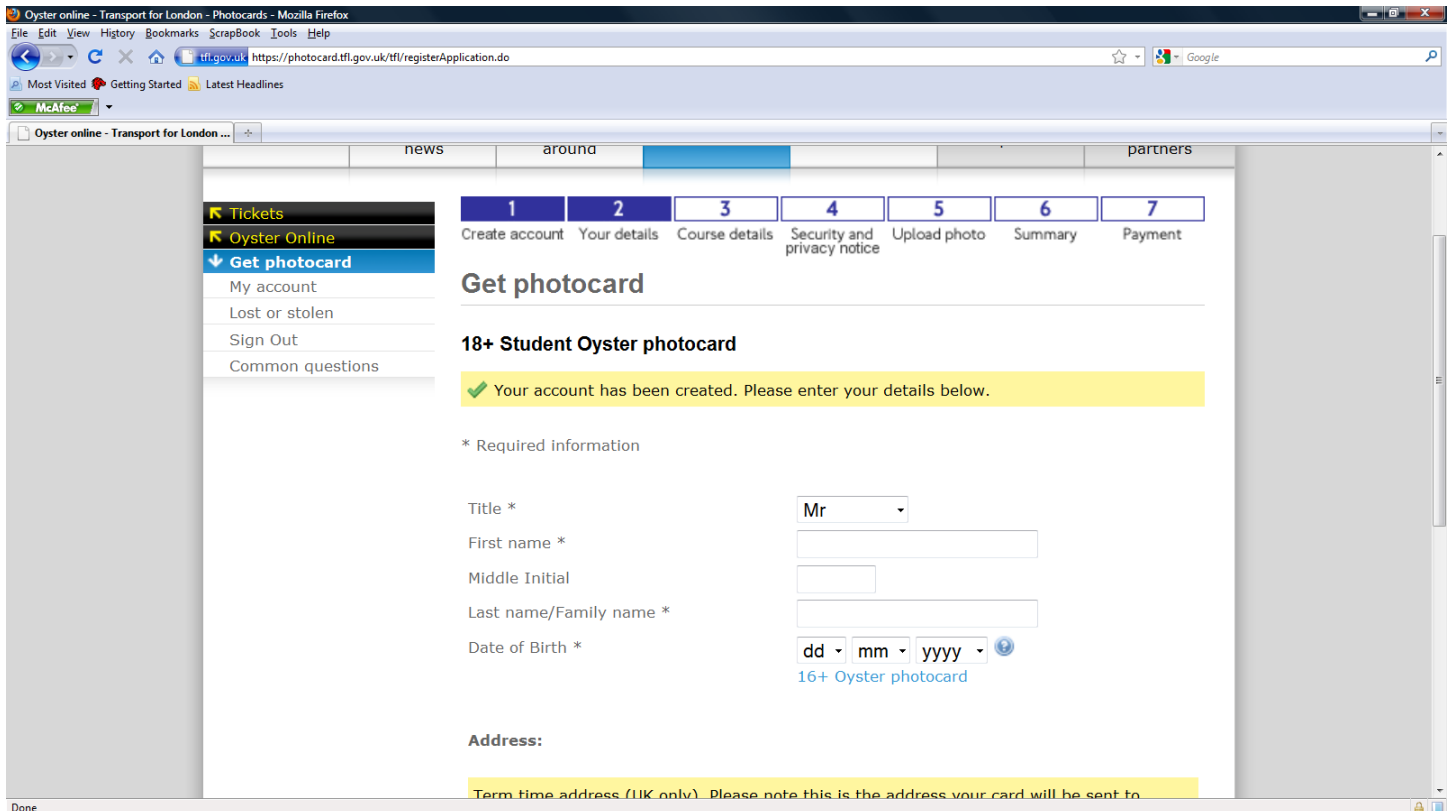
- 1- Go to <http://www.tfl.gov.uk/photocards>.
- 2- Click on the “18+ Student” link.
- 3- Enter the name of our school: [Language Studies International, London Hampstead](#), and click “Apply now”.
- 4- Type your email address and choose a password. Click “Create account”.




5- Complete your personal information. You will be asked to write your address in London. It is easiest if you use the school address. Enter the school postcode **NW3 5QA** and then click "Look up". Select 'Language Studies International, 13 Lyndhurst Terrace' from the list that appears. They will send your card to the school for you to collect it.

6- You can enter the school telephone number instead of your own if it is easier : 020 7794 8111.

7- Click "Continue".



8 - Enter your student enrolment (ID) number. You can find this on your LSI enrolment confirmation or visa letter.



8- Then complete your course dates and click “Continue”.

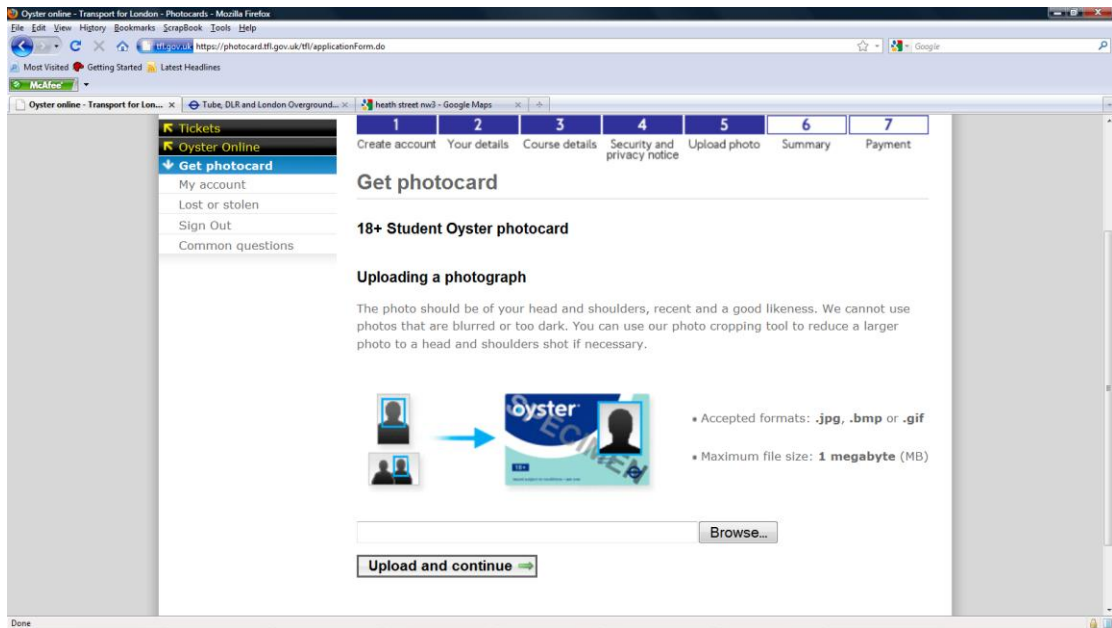
9- On the next page, choose a security question from the list. Type the answer and confirm it by writing it again.
