Muir Woods is a National Monument 12 miles north of San Francisco. It consists of numerous hiking trails through a coastal redwood forest that allow you see these massive and ancient trees up-close.



Marin Headlands is a peninsula just north of San Francisco that is famous for its spectacular views of the Bay Area, and in particular of the Golden Gate Bridge. This is a prime location for the perfect San Francisco/Golden Gate Bridge photo opportunity.

INFORMATION

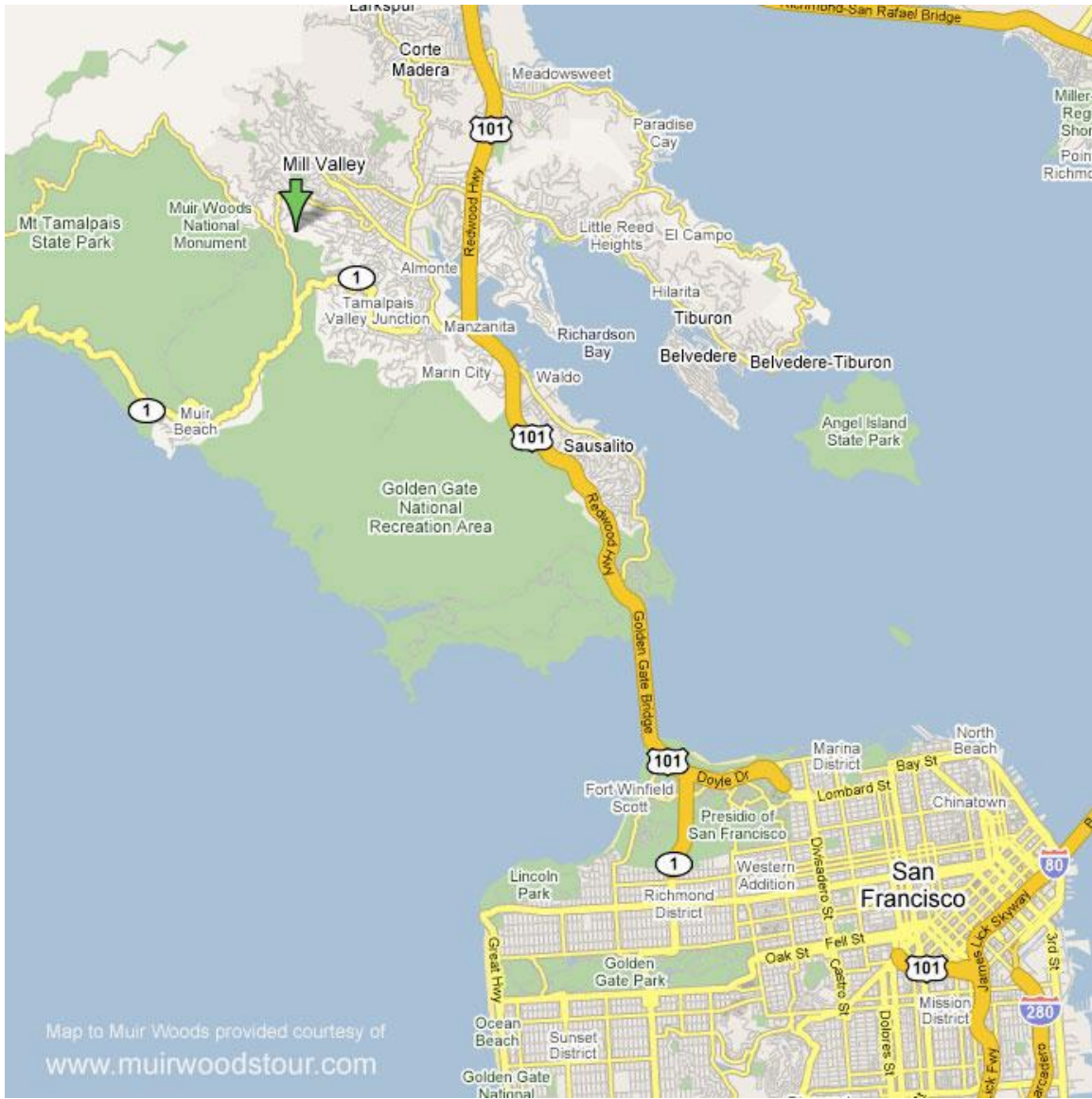
- **Date:** August 11th tentative
