Pre A Level

GCSE COURSES FOR AGE 16+, IELTS 4-5.



Each year LSI Independent College can accept a small cohort of 16+ students on one-year intensive GCSE courses. The Pre A Level Programme is designed for students aged 16, equivalent to Year 11 in the British educational system. The primary goal of this programme is to prepare students for A Level subjects and their future university pathways.

Students will take English and Math GCSE exams by the end of the year, while other subjects are tailored to their individual strengths. The curriculum includes:

Mathematics: 5 hours per week

English: 5 hours per week

Science (Biology, Chemistry, Physics): 5 hours per week

Humanities (Literature, History, Politics, Art): 5 hours per week

Physical Education (PE): 2 hours per week

Personal, Social, Health and Economic Education (PSHE): 1 hour per week

LSI also offers online GCSE support to external students.

Intensive A Level Courses

The Intensive A Level programme at LSI Independent College is designed for students who have completed Year 2 but wish to improve their grades by repeating their studies. This programme allows students to retake 1 to 3 subjects, with a focus on intensive learning and support.

One-year Intensive A level Re-sit

Our intensive one-year re-sit programme provides students with the opportunity to improve their current A level grades and reach their full potential. Our teachers give a great deal of attention to individual students' needs while our specialised UCAS support helps to make each student's application more effective.

One-year Upper Sixth Courses

Students may transfer into the second year of our A level programmes and continue their studies with us. Our one-year upper sixth course provides students with the opportunity to gain further understanding and skills that they may have missed during the first year of their studies. Academic & Extra-curricular Programme

International Students

Overview

Our curriculum is designed with international students in mind, featuring popular subjects for both UK and overseas learners. We ease their transition with a friendly atmosphere, an induction programme, and our Hampstead location—leafy yet near central London’s cultural riches. Integration drives success and well-being, supported by our extra-curricular programme and interactions with diverse peers.

Each international student has a Director of Studies overseeing academic and pastoral care, providing regular feedback to parents via an education guardian if needed. Expert university advice is delivered through this system. With 50 years of

English language expertise, we offer tailored support for exams or IELTS (minimum 5.5 required), including college-set tests and pre-course interviews (in-person or Skype).

Pre-sessional English Programmes

For students below 5.5 IELTS, our 50-year legacy in language training offers pre-sessional courses in July and August at LSI Independent College. A Level students needing more time can extend studies and join our 18-month programme, subject to prior performance and visa rules. Visit our website for details.





Guardianship

ALL INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS MUST HAVE A DESIGNATED EDUCATION GUARDIAN WHILE IN THE UK. THIS PROVISION ENSURES THAT THERE IS A CONTACT PERSON AVAILABLE TO ACT ON BEHALF OF THE STUDENT IN CASE OF EMERGENCIES.

UKGuardianship (UKG) provides comprehensive support services for international students throughout their UK education journey. Their WeCare A++ program offers complete academic and personal support including regular progress monitoring, mentoring, university preparation guidance, 24/7 emergency assistance, visa and documentation help, accommodation

arrangements, and transportation services.
