COURSE DESCRIPTION

LSI's English for Teaching course is designed to equip non-native speakers of English with the basic tools required to teach English as a Foreign Language.

Students may gain experience teaching LSI international students during the 4th week of the course.

Each course can be tailored on arrival through negotiation with the teacher, based on the students previous knowledge, experience, area of interest and English Level.

LSI's End-of-Course Certificate will be presented to students upon successful completion of the course.

Students will study 3 TKT modules over 4 weeks:

Module 1	Language and background to language learning and teaching
Module 2	Lesson planning and use of resources for language teaching
Module 3	Managing the teaching and learning process

Students may present the TKT exams at the end of their programme. The 3 modules can be taken on the same day. Consult with the school for exam dates and pricing.
