To book a place on an Easter Revision course the person responsible for fees must complete and sign the registration form and sign the declaration confirming that they have read and agreed to these terms and conditions. The registration form must be returned to the college along with the Easter Revision fees after which confirmation of successful enrolment will be acknowledged in writing by the college. **When making payment by bank transfer please quote the student's name.**

Failure to give correct information will constitute a material breach of any agreement(s) entered into between the college and you in relation to the education of the applicant student entitling the college to terminate all and any such agreement(s) without any obligation to return any fees paid.

If it is impossible to form a group of at least two in any Easter Revision course, the college undertakes to provide half the usual number of hours of individual tuition for the same fees as for the group courses. If, on the other hand, a place has been offered specifically for individual tuition, then the hourly individual rate applies.

To withdraw from an Easter Revision course written notice must be given by 25th February 2019 to ensure the reimbursement of course fees. Any student who withdraws from the programme after that date will not be entitled to any refund.

Absence from classes for whatever reason, including sickness, does not lead to a refund of fees, nor can the college be expected to provide extra lessons to compensate for such absence without charge.

The college reserves the right to terminate the courses, either temporarily or permanently, of any student whose work effort or attendance is unsatisfactory or whose behaviour (whether on or off the premises) has been prejudicial to good order or college discipline or to the reputation of the college. In such cases, no refund of fees covering the period of exclusion will be made except at the discretion of the Principal.
