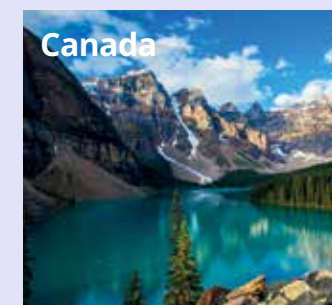

LSI's Working Holiday programmes are available to all students eligible for Working Holiday visas in the UK, Canada, Australia and New Zealand. Our Working Holiday programmes are also available for students studying on a general student visa in Australia and New Zealand. Please check with the LSI school or your local LSI representative for more information on work rights in your preferred destination.

Working Holidays in the UK

The Working Holiday is a unique way to experience life in the UK. Young people aged 18 to 30 can immerse themselves in British culture and learn English all whilst working to support their travel and study during an extended stay.

Currently the UK Government is offering Working Holidays to visitors from a select number of countries under the Youth Mobility Scheme.



The Youth Mobility Scheme allows you to:

- Live and work in the UK for up to 2 years
- Study full-time or part-time for any period of time during the lifetime of the visa
- Work full-time or part-time in most industry sectors
- Leave and enter the UK multiple times during the visa's time limit

In order to apply for the scheme, you will need to fulfil certain criteria:

- Be aged 18 to 30 at the commencement of the visa
- Have the minimum funds to support yourself on arrival in the UK (currently set at £1,890)
- Be a citizen of : Australia, Canada, Japan, Monaco, New Zealand, Taiwan, Hong Kong or South Korea



Application Process

Applicants for the Youth Mobility Scheme need to apply online from their own country 6 months or less before travel. You can only apply once for the scheme and visa decisions are usually made within 3 weeks. There is an annual cap on visa numbers and once the quota is reached no further applications will be accepted. The UK Home Office website gives details regarding the current allocations of places for each eligible country. In addition, if you are a citizen of South Korea or Hong Kong, you will need to be sponsored by your Government.

Working Holidays in Canada

Canada is often top of the list for many travellers. The great outdoors, from the grandeur of the Rockies to small secluded lakes and endless forests, draws many.

But Canada's appeal lies also in the country's reputation as one of the most liveable countries in the world with cities that are clean, safe, cosmopolitan and multicultural.

Canada offers Working Holiday Visas as part of the International Experience Canada Program (IEC). The program is ideal for international students who wish to explore this vast country and fund their travel and study by working during their stay. These visas are only available to citizens of countries where there are reciprocal Working holiday agreements, currently around 30 countries. For up-to-date information about which countries have Working Holiday allocations visit the CanadaVisa website.



Working holiday visas allows participants to:

- Work anywhere in Canada on an open work permit
- Work in any job sector in voluntary or paid employment
- Live and work in Canada for up to 12 or 24 months, depending on your country of citizenship
- Study for up to 6 months

Whilst the IEC Working Holiday Visa offer a lot of flexibility, there are some requirements that applicants need to fulfill:

- You need to be aged between 18 and 30 (for some countries the upper age limit is 35)
- Show proof of sufficient funds to sustain yourself and purchase your outbound ticket
- Work for a maximum of 6 months for one employer
- Have proof of health insurance for the duration of their stay



Application Process

The process for applying for the Working Holiday visa works on an 'invitation to apply basis'. The first step for eligible candidates involves creating a personal online profile. Candidate profiles are then entered into draws which take place at regular intervals throughout the year. If successful candidates are then invited to apply for the Working Holiday visa. As there is a cap on visa numbers for each country candidates must then wait to see if their application has been successful.

Working Holidays in Australia

A working holiday in Australia is the perfect way to improve your English whilst exploring this fascinating country. Young people from the ages of 18 to 30 can apply for either a Working Holiday Visa or Work and Holiday Visa and fund their travel and studies through paid work.

Whether you apply for the Working Holiday Visa or Work and Holiday Visa depends on which country you come from. For an up-to-date list check the relevant visa pages on the official Government website.



Application Process

Applicants for both types of working holiday visas, need to apply from their own country and processing applications generally takes up to 8 weeks. If applying for a second working holiday visa, this can be done directly in Australia. Please note, as visa caps apply on the Work and Holiday Visa, some applications may be turned down.

Both types of visas allow you to:

- Travel and work in Australia for up to 12 months
- Leave and enter Australia multiple times during the visa's time limit
- Extend your working holiday for a further 12 months when you work 88 days or more in specified work sectors (Working Holiday Visa or Work and Holiday Visa)
- Study for up to 17 weeks
- Work on a casual, part-time or full-time basis in any industry sector

Whilst the visas offer a lot of flexibility, there are some requirements that applicants need to fulfill:

- You need to be aged between 18-30*
- Show proof of sufficient funds to sustain yourself and purchase your outbound ticket
- Work for a maximum of 6 months for one employer*
- Additional requirements on Work and Holiday Visa holders applicants only include having a functional level English, tertiary qualifications and a letter of support from their home
- Meet Australia health requirements. It is recommended that you purchase health insurance to cover your stay in Australia

* Due to the restrictions on age and the limited length of work, some applicants prefer to apply for a Student visa where there are no restrictions for the lifetime of the visa.

Working Holidays in New Zealand

Working holidays in New Zealand are ideally suited to young people with the spirit of adventure. Despite being only the size of the UK, New Zealand is remarkable for its natural landscapes, abundance of sunshine and generally temperate climate.

Not many countries can offer the visitor such contrasting scenery: from the majestic snow-capped mountains, glaciers, fiords, thermal springs, dramatic volcanic plateaus, vast lakes to the gentle rolling farmlands and miles of sandy beaches. Sports and outdoor activities are also key to the Kiwi way of life, from high adrenalin activities such as bungee jumping and water rafting to hiking and sailing.

With a Working holiday visa, international students to New Zealand can fund their travel and study through paid work.



The visa allows you to:

- Travel and work in New Zealand for up to 12 months
- Work on a casual, part-time or full-time basis in any industry sector
- Leave and enter New Zealand multiple times during the visa's time limit
- Study for up to 6 months

In order to apply for the Working Holiday Visa, you will need to fulfil certain criteria:

- Be aged 18 up to 35 depending on your country of origin
- Show proof of sufficient funds to sustain yourself and purchase your outbound ticket
- Have proof of health insurance for the duration of their stay



Application Process

Working Holiday Visas are currently offered to 45 countries and the terms of the visa varies depending on the applicant's country of origin. The **NZ immigration website** gives details regarding the visa duration, age limits, visa caps and personal funds required for each country. Applications can be done online and be done both before travel to New Zealand or whilst you are there and take around 4 weeks to process.
