DEMI PAIR & AU PAIR PROGRAMME 2024

Program Overview:

The Demi Pair Programme is an excellent opportunity for students who want to study the English language in Brisbane and experience a typical Australian lifestyle at the same time. Demi Pairs are placed with a host family for 12-24 weeks while they study at Language Studies International (LSI).

Demi Pairs receive accommodation in a single room with three meals per day in the family home, in exchange for 15-20 hours of childminding and household duties each week – there is no financial exchange during the program. The Demi Pair is required to have two days off per week, while it is preferred that these days are consecutive and on a weekend, this may not be an option. The host family and the Demi Pair will agree upon a work roster which will outline the demi pairs days off.

The **requirements** to become a Demi Pair include:

- Age 18 – 27
- Must have childcare experience
- Happy to help the families with household duties (Cleaning, laundry)
- Minimum level of English: Intermediate (determined by LSI placement test)
- Minimum course length: 10 weeks of either General 20 or Intensive 24
- Course and placement to be taken simultaneously
- Driver's license
- Be eligible to apply for either Working Holiday, Work and Holiday or Student VISA
- Demi pair duties: 15-20 hours of childcare and light household work

This includes:

- 12-24 weeks Demi Pair placement with vetted families
- \$100 pocket money per week + school travel card

Fees for Demi Pair and Au Pair

First Placement fee (12 weeks)	AU\$995
Second placement fee (over 12 weeks)	AU\$795

These fees include:

Arrival airport transfer
Assistance with integrating into the new family
Any mediation necessary

Documents and blue card
Orientation session with city tour
LSI 24-hour emergency contact

When deciding on arrival dates, please ensure that the Demi Pair arrives at least two days prior to the class starting date. The Demi Pair can start classes any Monday for General English and therefore it is recommended that the Demi Pair arrive either the Friday or Saturday before course start date.

The Host Families:

Our host families are chosen with care. The approval process includes an in-depth application form outlining the family values, an interview, and a home visit to ensure that the Demi Pair has the best possible experience during placement. Host families live within a 50-minute bus trip from LSI, which is at the heart of Brisbane City.

Upon Arrival:

Demi Pairs receive an airport arrival transfer. The transfer company collects the Demi Pair upon arrival in Australia and transports them to their new home.

On the first day of school, the Demi Pair must arrive at 8:30 AM for placement testing and an orientation session. During the first week at LSI, the Demi-Pair coordinator who coordinates the Demi Pair Programme has a private meeting with each new Demi Pair to clarify any questions, to assess the weekly work roster to ensure the work is balanced and fair, and to apply for a Queensland Working With Children Blue Card. There will be regular meetings between the Demi Pair and the Demi-Pair coordinator to ensure a successful placement.

The enriching cultural exchange is a wonderful experience for both the Demi Pair and the host family. The Demi Pair will be treated as part of the family and will further benefit by speaking English everyday with the family, improving their own English language throughout the placement.
