English lessons



Lessons schedule: 9:30AM to 1:10PM, Monday to Friday (lessons can also be taught in the afternoon). Lessons are held at our school premises.



Materials: Notepad/paper and pen needed. Text books and study materials are provided on a loan basis. Wi-Fi is available in the school.



Class size: 18 student maximum.



Academic: The focus of lessons will mainly be on speaking, listening, vocabulary, and pronunciation skills with some emphasis on grammar, reading, and writing.



LSI Certificate: LSI certificate on completion of the programme.

Accommodation and meals

Homestay Accommodation

Accommodation are **twin rooms with a shared bathroom**. Each room includes a bed, a desk, a table, and storage space for clothing. Bed linens and towels are provided. The hosts will do one load of the student's laundry per week and Wi-Fi is available for students to use.

Breakfast is provided by the host and typically includes cereal, toast, fruit, juice, and tea or coffee. Lunch consists of a packed meal, which usually includes a sandwich or a salad, crisps and a fruit. Students will receive a cooked meal in their homestays in the evenings for dinner.

Residential Accommodation

Accommodation are **single rooms with a shared bathroom***. Each room includes a bed, a desk, a table, and storage space for clothing. Bed linens and towels are provided. Students can use the laundry room, laundry cards with \$0 can be collected from the front desk. Wi-Fi is available for students to use.

A hot breakfast is provided, including a selection of eggs, bacon, toast, yogurt, and more. Lunch consists of a packed meal that includes a sandwich, a snack, and a drink. A hot dinner is served in the evening, featuring a selection of salad, a main course, and dessert.

Curfew is at 10:00pm every evening for all students unless supervised on an LSI activity. Students must advise LSI at the time of booking of any dietary requirements. There is an additional fee for dairy, gluten free, and/or nut free diets.

Transport



Toronto Pearson International Airport:
45 minutes away from LSI Toronto

Transfer Service: We suggest booking an LSI transfer to ensure a safe transfer to their accommodation.

For individual students aged 15 or under, airport transport services are compulsory.

Traveling to School from Homestay: Our homestays are in various areas of the city, within a 60 minute commute from LSI. Two students will be placed in each of our families so that they can travel together.

Traveling to School from Residence: Average bus/subway journey from the residence is 10-30 minutes

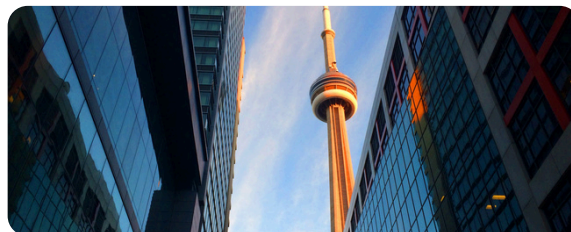
Traveling to Activities: Students travel to activities by bus, streetcar, or subway.
