English lessons



Lessons schedule: 9:00AM to 12:40PM, Monday to Friday (lessons can also be taught in the afternoon). Lessons are held at our school premises.



Materials: Notepad/paper and pen needed. Text books and study materials are provided on a loan basis. Wi-Fi is available in the school.



Class size: 18 student maximum.



Academic: The focus of lessons will mainly be on speaking, listening, vocabulary, and pronunciation skills with some emphasis on grammar, reading, and writing.



LSI Certificate: LSI certificate on completion of the programme.

Accommodation and meals



Accommodation in homestays are **twin rooms with a shared bathroom**. Each room includes a bed, a desk, a table, and storage space for clothing. Bed linens and towels are provided. The hosts will do one load of the student's laundry per week and Wi-Fi is available for students to use.

Curfew is at 10:00pm every evening for all students unless supervised on an LSI activity.

Breakfast is provided by the host and typically includes cereal, toast, fruit, juice, and tea or coffee. Lunch consists of a packed meal, which usually includes a sandwich or a salad, crisps and a fruit. Students will receive a cooked meal in their homestays in the evenings for dinner.

Students must advise LSI at the time of booking of any dietary requirements. There is an additional fee for dairy, gluten free, and/or nut free diets.

Transport



Vancouver International Airport:
35 minutes away from LSI Vancouver

Transfer Service: We suggest booking an LSI transfer to ensure a safe transfer to their accommodation.

For individual students aged 15 or under, airport transport services are compulsory.

Traveling to School: Our homestays are located in all areas of the city within 60 minutes from LSI.

All homestays are within easy access of bus routes.

Two students will be placed in each of our families so that they can travel together (subject to availability).

Traveling to Activities: Students travel to activities by bus, Skytrain, or Seabus.

Travel Cards are not included in the package so it is advisable for students to buy day passes that cover their staying.

Online Placement test **before arrival**.



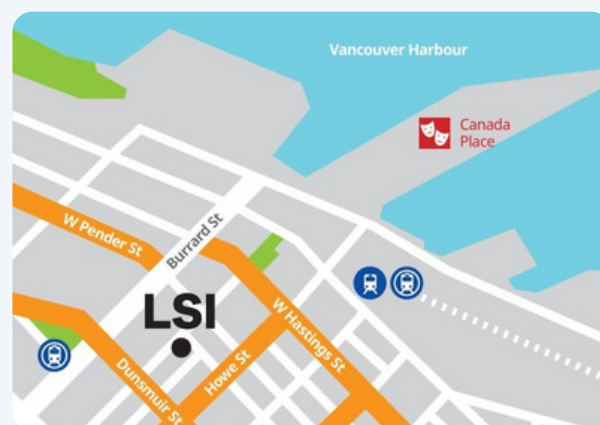
Upon arrival, host family welcomes the student, shows them their room, and explains how to reach the school.
