COURSE DESCRIPTION

The **Academic English** programme is designed to enhance students' listening, speaking, reading, and writing skills for academic purposes. Through a combination of classroom instruction, interactive activities, and real-world tasks, students will develop the language proficiency needed to succeed in academic settings.

This course focuses on the necessary skills that give students the best chance of meeting their chosen University or College's academic targets and expectations. Some of the skills covered are university research and presentation skills; effective communication in academic situations; exam skills and techniques; note taking and organising; and essay writing skills, including critical thinking and developing and presenting arguments.
